- 2. FNCCC competition format 24/25: First Grade either 8-10 team competition one and two day round pending numbers, all Saturday Cricket, prefer No Sunday Feedback to date 10 teams one full round of one day cricket and 6 rounds of two day cricket. 2<sup>nd</sup> grade FNC two conferences of 8 teams North and South Local association lower grades 3 & below.
  - CNSW and FNCCC CoM are currently working on a criterion for getting first grade from 10 to eight. Criteria to be out early, prior to season commencing and will not just be position based. Other criteria will support club health and growth, including juniors, etc.
- 3. Frogbox: FNCCC owns one: Cudgen owns one (Rugby League Club use every weekend) Casino CC request the use of one. FNCCC considering allocating a match of the round where the game will be streamed. Discussion around the logistics if moving the Frogbox around weekly was had with no outcome reached. To be kept open for solutions.
